For the Good of the Game	<p><u>Game situations</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Abusive Coach – In a recent U-10B game, there was verbal abuse directed toward the referee. A game report was filed with BCSA. You can't ignore abusive behavior when it is persistent. You need to deal with it. Don't say "Not one more word or I'll throw you out", since this gives you no recourse. If you do eject a coach and he doesn't leave or has no qualified assistant to take over, then you must terminate the game. 2. Player Swearing – Situation was a U-19 game. Swearing was not directed at anyone – judgement call on the part of the referee as to how it gets handled. If you hear it you could warn, caution or eject, but not ignore. Bottom line on 1 & 2 is you do not have to take abuse from a player, coach or spectator. 3. Injury Situation – Whistle with ball in play. Drop ball. 4. Flag Mechanics – It is important to "sell" your call by not hesitating and making a forceful flag movement.
